

WWSME Club Operating Rules 17-09-20:-

The WWSME site will have to change the way it is operated in response to the COVID 19 "Rule of Six". The challenge is to keep the club open for members whilst ensuring that attendance on site is restricted to a maximum of six people.

The site is available for members for six days per week – Thursday through Tuesday. Each day is split into a morning session from 9:00 to 12:00, and an afternoon session from 12:30 to 4:00. The normal Friday morning meeting is suspended. Wednesday is reserved for maintenance work. It is now a legal requirement that all attendees are recorded for track and trace, so places must be booked in advance. Peter Brougham has volunteered to run this booking process. If you have not booked a session on site please do not turn up. The clubhouse will not be opened up, it is the outside facilities that are available.

- 1) The site is available for a total of up six people pre-booked in any session.
- 2) Contact details have to be left for track and trace purposes when booking.
- 3) A booking needs to be made by contacting Peter Brougham on peter_fred@hotmail.co.uk The booking needs to be confirmed by Peter to be valid.
- 4) The main gate now has a combination lock. The combination will be given when a booking is confirmed. The member making the booking is responsible for site safety and security whilst present and on leaving. The 5" gauge track must be safety checked before running any loco. At the end of the session the gate must be locked by clicking the padlock closed and spinning the tumblers.
- 5) A keysafe will contain the toilet block keys.
- 6) Every member using the 5inch track must inspect it prior to operation to ensure it is safe. If there is any problem do not run and please notify a member of the committee as a matter of urgency.
